## Strengthening Our Defenses: External Biosecurity

As disease pressures continue to evolve, so too must our biosecurity standards. With this in mind, we have strengthened our measures and implemented several new layers of protection to safeguard the health and integrity of our production systems.

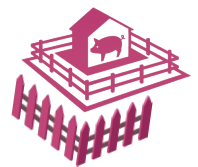


**High-pressure chassis disinfection**

Vehicle movement remains one of the highest-risk factors around production facilities. To address this, we have introduced a high-pressure chassis and wheel disinfectant spray system. This complements our existing spray-race, providing deeper and more consistent coverage to eliminate potential contaminants carried on vehicles entering or leaving the farm.

**Double fencing**

A major upgrade across our production sites is the installation of double fencing to create an additional barrier. This significantly reduces the likelihood of stray animals, wildlife, or unauthorized individuals approaching the production areas. By extending the buffer zone around our units, we lower the risk of disease transmission from external sources, an increasingly important measure in a high-pressure biosecurity environment.

**Shower facilities for drivers**

To minimize the risk of introducing pathogens through human contact, dedicated shower facilities for drivers are now operational. All drivers are required to shower and change into clean clothes before and after loading animals, creating a controlled transition point that protects both our herds and those of our partners.

**Clear signage for controlled movement**

To further improve access control, we have installed new, highly visible signage that guides staff, transporters, and visitors along the correct sequence and flow through designated areas. Clear direction helps maintain controlled access, reduces confusion, and supports adherence to our strict movement protocols.

**Awareness posters and training**

Biosecurity is not only about infrastructure, but also about awareness and behaviour. We have rolled out clear, informative biosecurity awareness posters across our sites to reinforce critical practices. These visual reminders help ensure that everyone entering the production environment remains informed and vigilant about their role in keeping our animals safe.
